A ledger can be an electronic computer file, loose-leaf pages in a binder, or cards in a tray. The accounting records are often referred to as the books because accounting was done in ledger books until recently. Accounting software frequently identifies ledger accounts with a book symbol.

The General Ledger The general ledger is a collection of the firm's accounts. While the general journal is organized as a chronological record of transactions, the ledger is organized by account. In casual use the accounts of the general ledger often take the form of simple two-column T-accounts.
