I thought that I had to fear for my life The first myth is that an officer must fear for her life before using deadly force "I feared for my life" is like saying, "I did it for officer safety" It is a subjective conclusion and plays no part in the fact bound determination about whether the force was reasonable

If I'm in fear for my life, I can use deadly force The law of justification has nothing to do with "fear" It's based on some very simple principles that should guide every officer, whether using deadly force or non-deadly force Keep these in mind: The law requires you to use the least amount
